### 24 Solaris trolleybuses to be delivered to Budapest

**Consortium of Solaris Bus & Coach and Škoda Electric signed a contract with Budapest City Transport (BKK) for the delivery of 24 Solaris trolleybuses. Fourteen units of the 12-metre version and ten articulated trolleybuses will be delivered until the end of 2015. The order includes also an option for a further 84 trolleybuses on the same terms.**

**amp; Coach and Škoda Electric signed a contract with Budapest City Transport (BKK) for the delivery of 24 Solaris trolleybuses. Fourteen units of the 12-metre version and ten articulated trolleybuses will be delivered until the end of 2015. The order includes also an option for a further 84 trolleybuses on the same terms.**

Solaris manufactures these trolleybuses in cooperation with Škoda Electric. The Czech producer delivers the trolleybus traction system and a battery set which makes the vehicle able to operate away from overhead wires at least 4 kilometers. Each vehicle is fitted with the Škoda BlueDrive system and electric motors delivering 160 kW in the 12-metre standard version and 250 kW in the articulated trolleybuses.

All vehicles are completely low-floor, air-conditioned and equipped with a CCTV monitoring system which ensures the safety of passengers. Furthermore, there is a reversing camera as standard. Interior LED lighting makes the journey much nicer, LED daytime driving lights outside the bus increase safety.

'Budapest is already a leading city in Europe as far as electromobility – electric transport – is concerned. This is best illustrated by the existing metro, tram and suburban railway network. In addition, Budapest boasts one of the longest trolleybus networks in Europe and even worldwide. The current procurement of brand new trolleybuses has been supported by EU funds covering 99% of expenditure. This present contract with Solaris lays the foundation of the future of trolleybus transport in Budapest,' emphasised BKK CEO Dávid Vitézy at the signing of the agreement

Solaris vehicles have been present in Hungary since 2002. So far, nearly ninety Solaris buses and trolleybuses have been running on Hungarian streets – in the capital city of Budapest as well as in Debrecen and Nyíregyháza, towns in the northeast of the country. With the new order from Budapest, Solaris Bus & Coach strengthens its position as the biggest trolleybus manufacturer in the European Union.
